The Southern Arizona Chapter of the American Guild of Organists was established on April 19, 1937. Henry Switten, Dean of the University of Arizona School of Music, was elected the first dean, and the new chapter was announced in the June 1937 issue of the Diapason.

From that time until now, the chapter has brought national and international artists to Tucson and has sponsored countless programs and workshops, including a national conference, a Region IX AGO Convention, and an 80th anniversary celebration in April 2017. Our chapter continues to fulfill its purpose to promote the organ in its historic and evolving roles, to encourage excellence in the performance of organ and choral music, and to provide a forum for mutual support, inspiration, education, and certification of Guild members.
