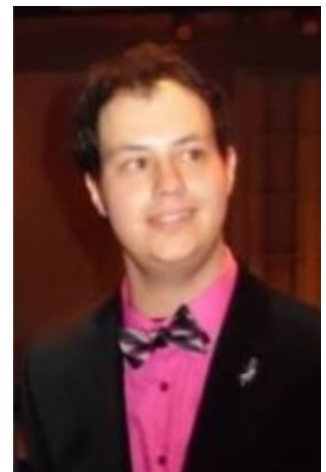

The Organ at Grace St. Paul's

The original 35-rank organ for Grace Episcopal Church was built in 1959 by David McDowell. In 1991, the parishes of St. Paul's Episcopal and Grace Episcopal merged. The organs in the two churches were also merged, again by David McDowell, who added new pipes and a new moveable console. In 1996, Pipe Organ Artisans of Arizona, Inc., Carl Anderson, and Grahame Davis enlarged the organ, adding new accompaniment voices, mixtures, and chorus reeds, along with new slider chests. The refurbished organ now has a total of 58 ranks in four divisions.
